Public Involvement Meeting Notice

Improvements to structure on McNulty Road

Planned improvements for the structure on McNulty Road in the Town of Adams, Jackson County, will be discussed at a public involvement meeting on December 10, 2024. The meeting will be held at the Adams Town Hall, N7370 US HWY 12/27, Black River Falls, WI 54615. A presentation on the project will be included at the beginning of the meeting that is scheduled from 6 PM to 6:45 PM.

The McNulty Road structure project involves improvements to the roadway and structure at the crossing of Branch Town Creek approximately 0.6 miles north of County Road A. The project includes replacement of the existing structure and minimal work along the roadway approaches. McNulty Road is a dead-end roadway. During construction of the project, the road will remain open to traffic by use of a temporary bypass on the west side of the existing bridge. Construction is anticipated to take approximately 3 to 4 months during 2026. The exact timeframe will be determined by in-stream work restrictions and contractor availability. A temporary easement will be needed to build the temporary bypass.

A variety of exhibits and maps will be featured at the public involvement meeting, and a representative from Ayres Associates will be available to discuss the project and answer questions. The public is encouraged to attend to examine the proposed improvement and discuss any concerns they might have.
